### **Technical Specification for Self-straining Frame for Load Testing**

The detailed design drawing of the self-straining steel frame is provided in Annexure-1. This steel frame will be used for load testing structural components such as beams, slabs, columns, etc. for vertical and lateral loads of magnitudes up to 2000kN. Therefore, high quality control and precision is expected in the fabrication of these frames. Following are the technical specifications/requirements for the fabrication and erection of the steel frame.

- 1. The vendor is responsible for fabrication, transportation and erection of the steel frame in the two storey Workshop at IIT Palakkad, Nila Campus, Kanjikode. The vendor is expected to visit the site to plan the erection.
- 2. The vendor should have fabricated structural steel buildings/frames totalling not less than 100T in the last two years. Additionally, at least one of the projects in the last two years should be of quantity not less than 50T.
- 3. The main beams, columns and cross-girder type-1&2 (Refer Annexure-1) are parallel flange beams (NPB 450x190@92kg/m) with the yield stress of 350 MPa. The steel sections should be manufactured by TATA(TISCO), JINDAL, JSW STEEL LTD. or SAIL.
- 4. Plate girders (loading girder, cross-girder type-3; Refer Annexure-1), stiffeners, diaphragms, end plates etc. should be fabricated from steel plates confirming to EN 300 or better of yield stress 300 MPa. The steel plates should be manufactured by TATA (TISCO), JINDAL, JSW STEEL LTD. or SAIL.
- 5. Test certificate for the yield and ultimate strength of the steel should be submitted to IIT Palakkad during erection.
- 6. High strength friction grip bolts confirming to IS1367 (Part-3)-2002 of grade 10.9 as specified in the drawings should be used.
  - a. The nuts and washers also should be of same grade.
  - b. Make: Puja forge Limited Faridabad, TVS or Hilti
  - c. At least 3 additional bolts from the sample should provided to us for testing
- 7. All welding recommended in the drawing should be shop welding. No site welding is acceptableunder any circumstances.
  - a. All major welds should be done using a fully automated welding facility. The vendor should submit the details of the fully automated welding facility along with the technical bid.
  - b. The vendor should demonstrate the quality of the weld through dye penetration tests.
- 8. Fabrication drawings prepared by the Vendor should be submitted to IIT Palakkad within 3 weeks from the date of award of the purchase order. These drawings will be checked and approved by the competent authority at IIT Palakkad

### 9. Painting

- a. One coat of Etch primer followed by two coats of zinc chromate primer (MRF, Asian Paints or equivalent)
- b. Two or more coats of enamel paint (Colour: Synthetic Golden Yellow)
- 10. Any changes from the drawings can be done only with the approval of competent authority from IIT Palakkad.
- 11. Officials from IIT Palakkad may visit the fabrication yard of the technically qualified vendors before the award of the tender, and during the fabrication process.
- 12. The entire frame should be erected at the fabricator's yard for inspection by officials from IIT Palakkad, before they are transported to IIT Palakkad.
- 13. The fabrication and erection of the steel frame in the two storeys Workshop at IIT Palakkad should be completed within 3 months from the issue of purchase order

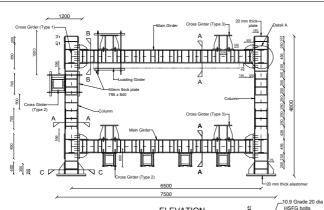

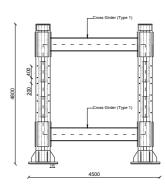

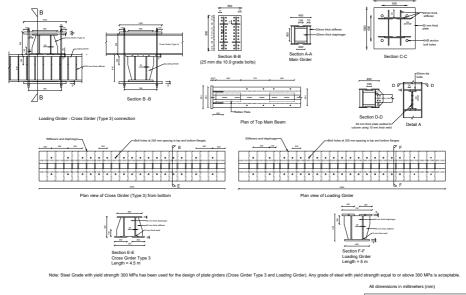
