The FS of other bidders will be determined using the formula: $FS=20 \times FP/F$, where FP is the lowest financial bid and F is the financial bid of the particular bidder. Scores obtained on financial offer will be added to scores obtained on technical offer to get a consolidated score (CS) according to the formula: $CS=TS+FS$.
